

# My Arthur Cartoon

## Objective

- to draw pictures that tell an original ARTHUR story

## Materials

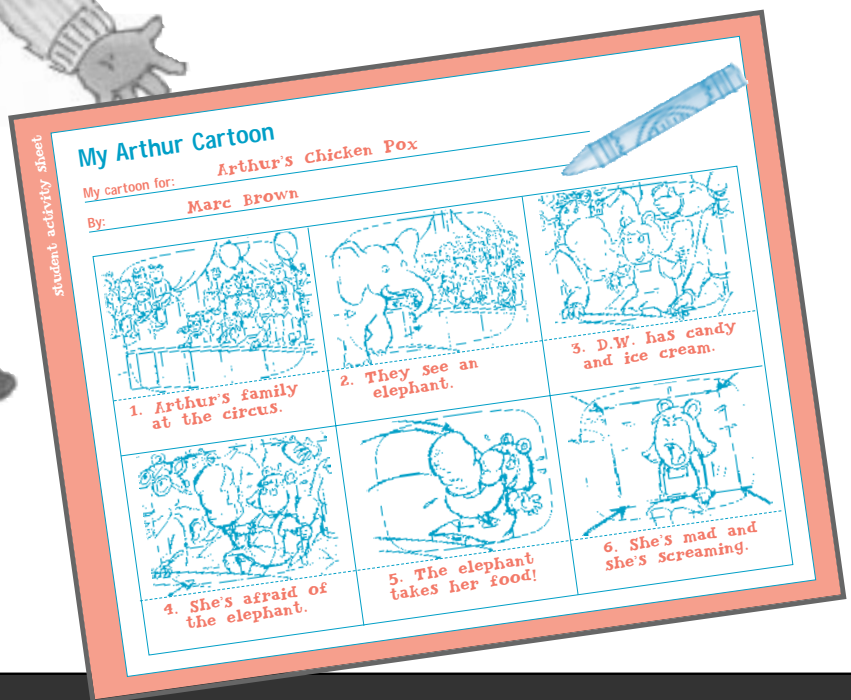
- colored pencil and/or crayons
- My ARTHUR Cartoon activity sheet
- overhead transparencies (optional)

## Directions

- 1 Have students use the My Story Plan activity sheet (page 21) to create an original ARTHUR story.
- 2 Help students to identify, list, and sequence eight scenes in their story.
- 3 Distribute a My ARTHUR Cartoon activity sheet to each student.
- 4 Have students use colored pencils to sketch the scenes on the activity sheet. Ask them to add captions or cartoon bubbles to each panel.

## Activity Options

- Have students use this activity to sketch rough illustrations that they can redraw later when they illustrate their original ARTHUR stories.
- Enlarge the My ARTHUR Cartoon activity page to create a larger format for students' artwork.
  - Have students use markers to draw cartoons onto transparencies and share them with the class using an overhead projector.
  - Let students choose another ARTHUR story to read and then retell in the cartoon format with a partner or small group.
  - For younger children, fold larger paper to create a page with fewer frames and bigger spaces.
  - Teachers or upper-grade students draw pictures on the activity sheet based on students' ideas.
