

## **Cornerstones** Matching Games: Instructions

Print out these word sheets, cut along the dotted lines (careful, now!), and play some great matching games, making compound words or matching synonyms.

Lay all the words from either sheet face up on a table, and then match the words that go together. Once you find a pair, remove the words from the table. Take turns finding pairs. Note that with the compound words, some words have more than one match.

For a different challenge, use the synonym tiles to play "Concentration" (the memory game). Lay all the words from the synonym sheet face down on a table. Turn over one word, and then try to turn over its partner. If you're right, take them off. If you're wrong, then turn both words face down again, and keep trying!
