Matching Games: Instructions

Print out these word sheets, cut along the dotted lines (careful, now!) and play some great matching games. Both sets of words are in pairs.

For a simpler game, lay all the words from one sheet face up on a table, and then match the words that go together. Once you find a pair that go together, remove the words from the pile. Take turns finding pairs.

For more of a challenge, play "Concentration" (the memory game). Lay all the words from one sheet face down on a table. Turn over one word, and then try to turn over its partner. If you're right, take them off. If you're wrong, then turn all the words face down again, and keep trying!

Make sure to remember what kind of matches you're looking for in each game.
